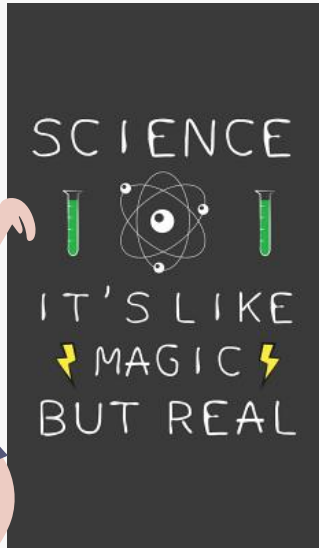


March 2022 Preschool Newsletter

22 March - World Water Day

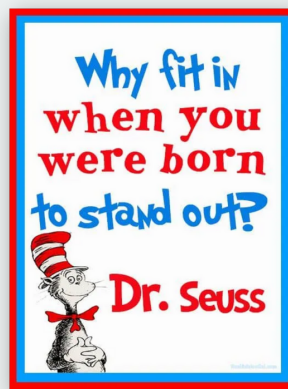
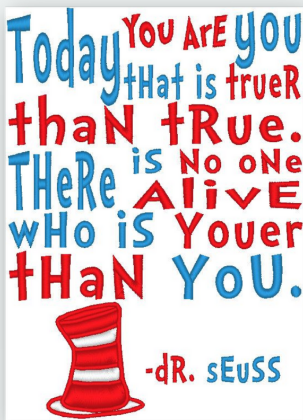
25 March - United Nations Day - Class Picnic and dress in cultural colours or national dress
